He is a highly respected advocate, who concentrated his practice on civil and criminal trials, arbitrations and civil appeals. For decades, Lester appeared in state and federal trial courts and before the Wisconsin Court of Appeals, the Wisconsin Supreme Court, and the 7th Circuit Court of Appeals.

Since 2005, he has been a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers, an honor that no more than one-percent of the attorneys in any state of the United States or province of Canada may receive.

**TALK HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Practicing law is sometimes provocative.
- Lawyers must focus on the elements of cases that are not always readily known by lay people.
- Most cross-examinations you see in the movies and on TV are nonsense.
- Jury trials involve more communications between the lawyers involved and the jury, but it isn't verbal.
- Arguments and cases before multi-judge appeals courts is challenging.
- Believe it or not, clients do not always take their lawyer's advice.
